Happy Spring,

April showers bring May flowers. If that is the case, we should have quite the flowers this month. The showers we have had in April are welcomed and needed, so we should enjoy the new birth of plants we have not seen in a while. Enjoy the beauty and smells of the new growth. May you be blessed by this work of art that God will be

bringing through the water.

We continue in the season of Easter for a few more weeks as we hear about the days, weeks, months ... after Christ's resurrection and ascension. We learn that believers in The Way, sold everything and gave the proceeds to the newly formed "church." All was shared and given out as was needed. They gathered in praise and thanksgiving, but also in fear as they were persecuted by Romans and Hebrews. Even though this threat was real the believers continued with their commission to "go and make disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 28)

What it must have been like in those early days as we see accounts of people being baptized daily and on Pentecost 3,000 people were converted and baptized. Sharing one's faith and having non-believers hearing the truth for the first time.

Friends, we are still in the time. Easter Season will only last a few more weeks then we have Pentecost where we will hear about the tongues like fire, people hearing the message in their own language and the apostles preaching, testifying and ministering to the crowds, even baptizing them.

LCIF DONATES TO MAKING IT HAPPEN, INC.




After treatment, Flo started preschool, which became a place for healing, growth and budding friendships. Inspired by the




