GREETINGS FROM PASTOR RICK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



We just finished a marathon on bread in worship. Many long weeks on how Jesus fed thousands, how He tried to teach the masses, then His closer disciples, what it was to eat of His flesh and drink of His blood. A hard lesson for those 2,000 plus years ago and still difficult for us now in the 21st century. Christ came to feed the world, both

worldly and spiritually. As He institutes our second sacrament, Holy Communion, He gives us access to God and helps fulfill His promise of forgiveness of sins and eternal life. He also invites us to abide in Him, thus Him in us.

Christ invites us into the ministry of feeding. So I have asked you, in worship, to think about ways that we, as individuals and as LCIF, can feed the world. To bring those to worship so that we can have a list to see. This feeding will be all over the board and that is good, there is no wrong answer. Please remember that we are tasked with feeding spiritually as well as worldly.

What is it that you need? Far too often when we turn to feeding others, we neglect ourselves and I want to make sure that we are attending

The Los Angeles branch, which our congregation has supported with a grant from our endowment fund, is celebrating its 100th anniversary in attempting to meet the needs of its members through ou housing services, psychiatric and group therapy sessions, substance abuse interventions, and more.

The agency also provides opportunities for members to work with the catering services through involvement with its own enterprise, the Village Cookie Shoppe. In 2023 alone, the agency served over 19,000 members, providing meals and medical services, as well as assisting some 2,200 of its members in obtaining housing.

We are very blessed to support agencies such as MHALA that are living out Jesus' admonition that we serve the "least of these" in our community.
